**REQUIREMENT #1:** First Aid Merit badge date earned \_\_\_\_\_

**OPTIONAL PREPARATIONS:** The items below may be things that a scout might want to prepare for, complete written assignments and be ready to present at this session to complete the requirements to earn the E-prep merit badge BEFORE coming to the merit badge college.

## Written assignments:

- I. A. Complete written charts for the preparation, response, recover and mitigation of the following situations:  
**Home kitchen fire, basement/storage room/garage fire, explosion in home, automobile accident and food borne disease or poisoning exposure.**
- B. Complete 5 additional scenarios listed on the E-Prep checklist.

These will be reviewed by the counselor during the session and then attached to the E-prep checklist.

- II. A. Scout should meet with their family to teach the above and include notes from that meeting indicating some specific actions each family member will take in case of those emergencies. This information should include:
  - a phone number and address of an out of state contact person the family will use as a resource should a disaster strike.
  - A specific location outside the home where the family will gather if the home would need to be evacuated in a hurry
  - A location within the city where the family will go in case their home or neighborhood is destroyed while they are away and/or separated

**REQUIREMENT #3, #4 and #5** Scout will be tested on several safety actions during merit badge class

**REQUIREMENT #6:** Complete written questions. Scout will be given information and tested on these during merit badge class

**REQUIREMENT #7:** Scout may want to have this service project completed before the class to fulfill all requirements for E-PREP. A description of the activity and scouts role in it should be completed in writing

## REQUIREMENT #8:

A and B- Complete the written requirements in #8 as much as possible. Additional information will be provided during the session to answer remaining questions.

**C- Bring your emergency service pack/family kit to the class, it will be checked off for completeness**

## REQUIREMENT #9

A-Complete the written requirements.

B-Be prepared to participate in discussions what preparations you made in completing this requirement

Each requirement must be completed and have a counselors initials verifying their completion to earn the E-Prep badge. It is completely up to each individual scout when he would like to achieve these. However, advance preparation for this class by completing as many of the above items will assist in fulfilling a number (if not all) of them by the end of the session.
